

SIMPLIFIED INSTRUCTIONS FOR REPLACEMENT/INITIAL I-94 APPLICATION (aka FORM I-102)

Revised 12/2010

(NOTICE: The US Citizenship and Immigration Services (CIS) has increased the FEE for Replacement/Initial I-94 Card from \$320.00 to \$330.00, effective November 23, 2010.)

This is a summary of instructions provided to help FSM Citizens when applying for a replacement/initial I-94 Card. Instruction details can be obtained from the FSM Embassy website (www.fssembassydc.org) or US Citizenship and Immigration Services website (www.uscis.gov).

All FSM citizens need to apply for a replacement I-94 card if their original I-94s have been lost, damaged or issued incorrectly. It is important that the information on your I-94 card matches the information on your Passport.

Below are simplified instructions to help you fill out the application for Replacement/Initial I-94(also known as I-102 form):

- 1.) Completely fill out both pages of the application form. All FSM Citizens are admitted into USA under the Compact of Free Association as "CFA/FSM". No visa is required and I-94 does not expire. I-94 is obtained by US authorities upon departure from USA.
- 2.) Attach US Postal Money Order in the amount of **\$330.00** for processing fee of your application. Write or type **U.S. Department of Homeland Security** on the Money Order. Initials such as **US DHS** or **DHS** are **NOT** acceptable and can unnecessarily delay processing of your application.
- 3.) Attach a copy of your FSM Passport and a copy of your I-94 if you have a copy.
- 4.) Processing of applications for FSM citizens is centralized. Please mail your application to:

Before mailing, ensure that your application is completely filled out, signed AND supporting documents and money order enclosed. Make a copy of your application package for reference and follow-up purposes.
